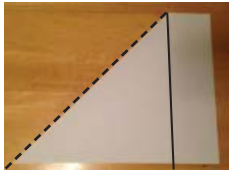


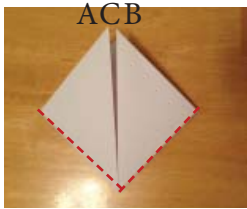
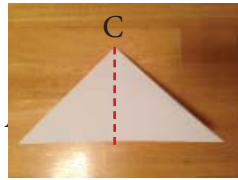
Origami Dove Instructions



1. Fold the short side of the 8.5" X 11" paper to meet the long side and fold. Cut off the paper not within the triangle created by the fold.

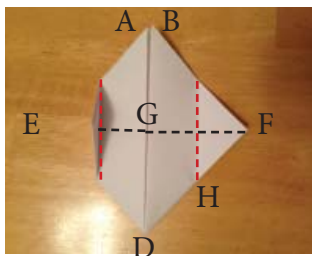
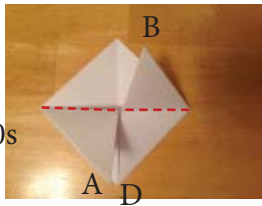


2. Fold the triangle in half and unfold it.



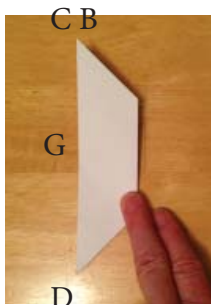
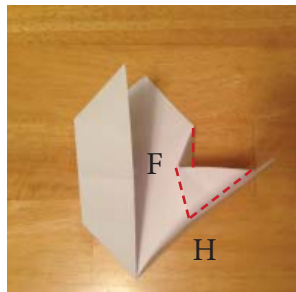
3. Fold corners A and B up to corner C.

4. Fold corners A and B down to corner D and unfold both of them.

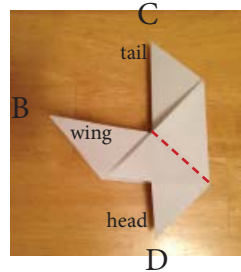


5. Fold corners E and F to the point where the fold from step 4 and the center folds meet (Point G). Unfold.

6. This is an inverted fold. Points E and F will be folded inside using the folds you made in step 5 as guides. Reverse the fold from F and crease it. One of the other two folds will also be reversed. When you finish both sides will look like the left side of this photo.

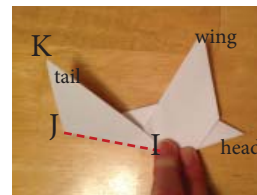
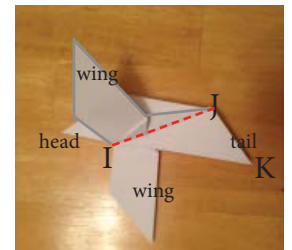


7. After the two inverted folds are done, turn the piece over so that the open flaps are on the table. Fold the piece in half making the open sides on the left and the inverted folds are on the right



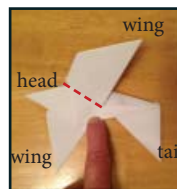
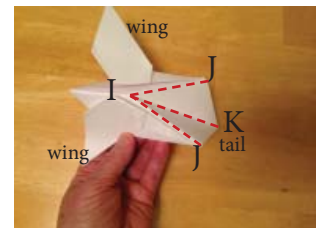
8. With open flaps A & B and fold C at the top and the open flaps at the left, fold corner B down and over to the left to create one wing. Turn the piece over and repeat with corner A toward the right.

9. This is the most difficult fold to see. With the wings pointed down, fold one wing up from point I to J. The outline of the wing is black and the fold is shown in red. Turn bird over and repeat with the opposite wing.



10. After folding both sides of the wings, fold the tail up along the fold you made in step 9. Turn it over and fold the tail in the opposite direction.

11. This fold is also an inverted fold as the one in step 6. Open the tail fold slightly. Fold from I to K in the opposite direction. One of the other folds will also be inverted. Invert the folds with ease and bring the two sides together again.



12. With the tail pointed down, fold one wing up along shown dotted line. Turn over and repeat with the other wing.



13. Open the body slightly and push down on the fold for the head, inverting part of the fold as the head and beak.
