The Amazing People of Illinois South Conference...

The seventh year is in the bag for the LUNCH Bunch in the Highland area. Our hope is that children have been nourished by the gifts that flowed from our gracious God through you as you gave of your time, talent, prayers and offerings. The tallies of lunches handed out, as well as offerings, juice boxes, treats and chips donated--it's absolutely incredible!! There were 16 churches

and several community organizations that came together this year. There were 145 volunteers that came to help at least once but many came several times and others every day! So many hands and feet of God!

Alhambra Salem UCC, also partnered with Highland to provide free summer lunches for students in need in the Highland School District. This ecumenical ministry served 10,374 free summer lunches during summer 2023. Thank you LUNCH Bunch which stands for Loving United Neighbors Crushing Hunger.
