Since the justice champions that secured the ADA are passing away, it is important that we preserve memories of their courageous actions. In 2024, we celebrate the life of Rev. Harold H. Wilke (1914-2003), a minister who gave an invocation at the White House signing of the ADA with Pres. George H.W. Bush. Wilke was born without arms on a farm in Washington, Missouri, and had to fight discrimination in school, in religious institutions, and in society throughout his life.








INTO THE DEEP AT GENERAL SYNOD 35
